

## \*THE FRENCH ART OF LIVING IN A 16TH-CENTURY CHÂTEAU

## Description:

After passing through a magnificent wrought-iron gate, one discovers more than 1,550 m<sup>2</sup> of built space. The estate extends over 3.6 hectares of forest and carefully landscaped gardens, bordered by a stream on the lower side.

The 16th-century Renaissance-style château is graced with two pepperpot towers, inviting exploration. A beautiful vaulted entrance leads to a splendid stone staircase that adds a noble touch. Two living rooms and a dining room, each boasting coffered ceilings reaching four meters in height, open directly onto the gardens.

The kitchen, adorned with a Gothic ribbed vault and a large fireplace, is one of the château's oldest rooms. It is complemented by a spacious pantry and a cold room. The property includes seven bedrooms, an office, a dressing room, and five bathrooms, as well as 105 m<sup>2</sup> of open-beamed rooms that can serve as a gym, games area, or exhibition space, all connected to various terraces.

The orangery, with its high vaulted ceilings and an interior fountain, opens directly onto the terraces and gardens, adding further charm to the ensemble. There is also the possibility of creating independent living quarters, accessible via one of the towers and its magnificent spiral staircase, enhancing the potential of this exceptional estate.

Two swimming pools complete the property: one heated pool is located within a former vaulted cellar, accessible directly from inside the château, while the second, an infinity pool, lies in the exterior gardens. A jacuzzi set on an elevated terrace offers panoramic views of the surrounding greenery.

The outbuildings and workshops, with a total area of 450 m², include a semi-underground vaulted wine cellar of over 100 m², perfect for wine enthusiasts. Practical installations include a water tower, three water collection basins with a total capacity of up to 450 m³, a garage, and shelters for four to five cars.
